TEMPORARY CLOSURE ON WEST WASHINGTON STREET SCHEDULED FOR MARCH 12 – 19

(Greenville SC) Weather permitting, the eastbound lane of West Washington Street, beginning at Nassau Street and extending to South Hudson Street, will be temporarily closed beginning Friday, March 12 for streetscape improvements, which will include installation of a landscaped median in the center of the roadway. This temporary road closure will be in effect weekdays during regular business hours. Unless precluded by safety hazards, the closed segment will be reopened at the close of business each day and on weekends.

Nassau Street, South Hudson Street and the westbound lane of West Washington Street will remain open during construction. Parking access for the Post Office will be available in the lot beside the building and in the paved lot at the corner of South Hudson Street and West Washington Street. The aforementioned lot may be accessed from South Hudson Street. Detour signs will be posted and eastbound motorists traveling to Butler Avenue are encouraged to follow the detour to Nassau Street to Oscar Street to South Hudson Street and then to West Washington Street to bypass the construction area. Additional, undesignated alternate routes are available.

Construction of the infrastructure improvement is expected to be completed in approximately one (1) week, weather permitting. Motorists traveling on West Washington Street are asked to use caution and to be aware of traffic control signage and flagmen.
