CITY BEGINS WORK ON WEST WASHINGTON STREETScape PROJECT

Enhancements designed to add aesthetic appeal and create more pedestrian connections

GREENVILLE (SC) The City began work this week along West Washington Street in front of the post office and the area in front of the Amtrak station as part of the West Washington Streetscape Project. The project is expected to last three months and has been scheduled to fit with SCDOT's planned resurfacing of West Washington Street this spring.

The goal of the project is to enhance the West Washington Street area by adding pedestrian infrastructure elements and landscape amenities. The project scope includes:

- Installation of new sidewalks
- Landscaping and street trees
- Landscaped medians
- Decorative lighting
- On-street parking
- Pedestrian crosswalks

Every effort will be made to keep West Washington Street open to traffic during construction, but temporary lane closures may be necessary at times and motorists traveling on West Washington may experience delays.
