### LOCAL

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- **Business Licenses:** Deferred deadlines for payment of new business licenses and business license renewals.
- **Taxes:** Suspended penalties and payment of local accommodations fees and hospitality taxes for the reporting periods due March 20, 2020 and April 20, 2020. If filed with the City by the appropriate due dates, payments will not accrue a late penalty until May 21, 2020.
- **Parking:** Working with businesses on a case-by-case basis. Contact Parking Services at 864-467-4900 on weekdays from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
