UNITY PARK IS OPEN

Thousands gathered at Unity Park for the grand opening celebration on Thursday!


Greenville's newest park features four state-of-the-art playgrounds, two expansive green spaces, covered picnic tables and the Prisma Health Welcome Center.

Three pedestrian bridges span the Reedy River, which flows through the middle of the park. The Swamp Rabbit Trail runs along both sides of the river. The park contains five additional looped walking trails.

- 1. One of the biggest highlights in the opening of Unity Park was involving children from nearby schools. Students from AJ Whittenburg Elementary and St. Anthony's Catholic School were among the first to test out the playgrounds, splash pad and musical features.
- 2. The West End Community Choir, a blend of members from neighborhood churches, lifted their voices in celebration during the grand opening. The City extends a special thanks to Tabernacle Baptist, Allen Temple AME, Mountain View Baptist, Israel Metropolitan, First Presbyterian and Pilgrim Baptist churches.
- **3.** The 4,100-square-foot Greenville Water Splash Pad is now open! It features 39 spray jets and includes a special toddlers-only zone, so younger visitors can explore safely.

Greenville City Council members and Mayor Knox White started the day of celebration by unveiling nine-foot-tall letters that welcome park visitors entering from Hudson Street.
