



## City of Greenville Redistricting Public Input Drop-In

The 2020 United States Census showed a shift in population density within the city limits, meaning districts are no longer balanced. The law requires equity, so the City's redistricting goal is to have four districts as close to the same number of people as possible.

The city of Greenville will be holding four public drop ins to receive input from city residents on Council's draft map. All information collected will be provided to City Council for consideration in finalizing the proposed Redistricting Map and adopting the same by Ordinance. The four drop-ins will be held as follows:
